RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION

The City of Statesboro would like to remind residents that there is a \$25 fine for waste containers that are consistently left at the curb in violation of the city's Code of Ordinances, Section 66-91.

As a reminder:

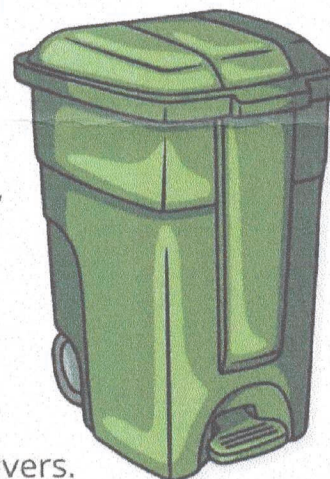
- Waste containers should be placed at the curb after 6 pm the night before your service day
- All containers should be removed from the curb by 8 am the day after your service day.

Residents receive a warning for the first violation, but for additional occurrences, a \$25 fine will be issued each time City crews have to roll their carts from the curb.

The Statesboro City Council approved this policy in December 2023, and would like to remind residents that it is still in effect.

Why do we ask residents to clear the curb?

Removing waste containers from the curb prevents litter, keeps property tidy, deters animals from scattering trash, and keeps the cart or trash from ending up in the roadway and posing a risk to drivers.
